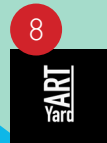

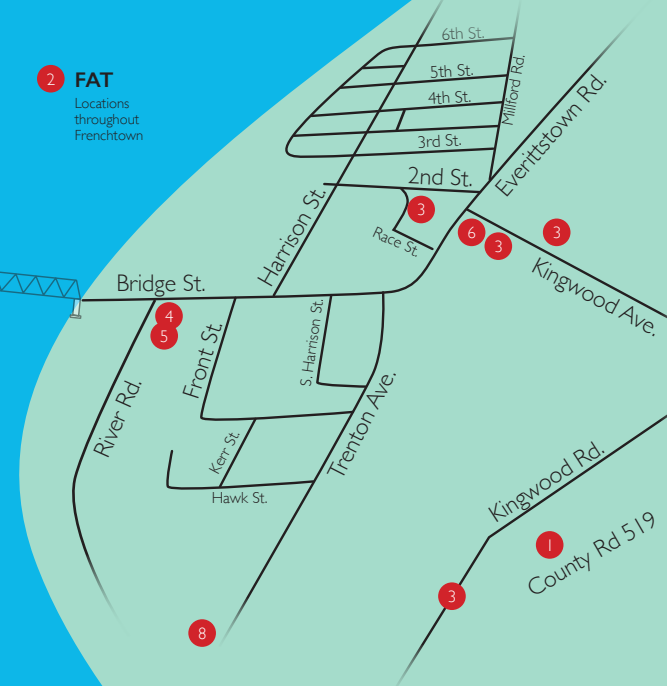

Shelter Is, curated by Lucinda Warchol, is on view through December 28th. The works on view consider traditional models of shelter, as well as unconventional perceptions of home, relief, and sanctuary. The gallery is open Friday-Sunday, 11AM-5PM.
