## Works added to New Hope outdoor sculpture exhibit

New Hope's long-running outdoor sculpture exhibit recently put three new works on view, with two more expected in time to mark the project's 13th birthday Sept. 10.

"Earth Piercing" by Michael Cooper is newly installed at the Free Library of New Hope & Solebury, 93 W. Ferry St. Placed in recent months are "Compassion" by Don Campbell, in The Studio Sculpture Garden at 127 N. Main St.; and at the The Ferry Landing park near the Bucks County Playhouse, "Sturgeon" by Kate Graves.

Works by Elizabeth Miller McCue and Peter Dellert are expected to be installed soon.

The exhibit has been ongoing, but last year got new funding and was retitled the PNC Arts Alive Outdoor Sculpture Project. Over the past 13 years, more than 65 works have been displayed. Maps and more
