MICHELLE LESTER

Michelle Lester (1942-2002) was a textile and fashion designer, illustrator, teacher and a tapestry weaver. She started her art carrier after getting her BFA from Cleveland Institute of Art and MFA from Syracuse University. Lester maintained her tapestry studio in NYC from late 70's through the 90's where together with her international crew of weavers over 200 large scale tapestries were created. Her work was commissioned by great number of industrial giants including Lincoln Properties, IBM, CityCorp and Pan Am.
